Bible Verses Intended for Meetings in the Home

As parents and serving ones, we would like to see our children growing up in the Lord's recovery to know God and to have the word of Christ dwell in them richly. This collection of 300 Bible verses is primarily intended for corporate family times in the home. In presenting the Bible verses, each verse includes its book and chapter reference. It is by no means that we consider these the "best verses" from the Bible but is intended to be the initiation of drawing greater emphasis on enjoying, understanding, and memorizing Bible verses among our children. This collection of verses is presented in three levels based upon the age of the children. This is provided only as a guideline since families often have children of various ages. Below are some quotes from the ministry of Witness Lee and Watchman Nee concerning memorizing Bible verses and having daily meetings in our homes with our children.

Brother Witness Lee highlighted the importance of sharing Bible verses with our children. He stated, "By choosing the best verses concerning God... we can impress them (the children) in a brief and simple way that there is an almighty One in the universe, who is our God." (The Collected Works of Witness Lee, 1967, Vol. 1, pp.504-505).

Brother Watchman Nee shared with us that "In order to have the word of Christ dwelling in us richly, at least we have to memorize the Scriptures." Brother Nee gave the example that "the Lord Jesus memorized the Scriptures while He was on earth." (How to Study the <u>Bible</u> by Watchman Nee, Chapter 3, Section 2, <u>By Memorizing</u>)

Brother Lee encouraged us to start early - The Bible verses memorization should begin early in the children's life. "... parents should teach their children when they are young so that what has been taught can be wrought into their "blood." Then it will be impressed deeply within them and will be difficult to forget." (Witness Lee, <u>Bearing Remaining Fruit</u>, Volume One, Chapter 16, Page 196)

Brother Nee writes in his chapter entitled "Parents", "We suggest having two home meetings a day, one in the morning and one in the evening. The father should lead the morning time and the mother should lead the evening time.... If you have children at home, you have to wake up earlier. Have a little time together before the children go to school. Your meeting should be short, living, and never long. Perhaps ten minutes is enough. Fifteen minutes is the longest it should be. Never exceed fifteen minutes and do not be shorter than five minutes. Ask everyone of them to read a verse. The father should take the lead to pick out a few phrases and speak about them. If the children can memorize something, ask them to memorize. Do not quote a whole verse. Ask them to remember the meaning of a sentence. At the end of the meeting the father or the mother should offer a prayer for God's blessing. Do not offer lofty or deep prayers. Pray about things that children can understand. Do not be long. Be simple. Then send them to school.

Every time you sit down for your meal, you should thank the Lord for it. Whether it is breakfast, lunch, or dinner, you should be sincere in your thanksgiving. Help your children to give thanks. The evening meeting should be a little longer, and the mother should lead

it. It is not necessary to read the Bible at night, but the family needs to pray together. In particular, the mother has to gather the children together and talk to them. While the father is sitting next to her, the mother should encourage the children to speak up. Ask them whether they had any problems that day. Ask whether they fought with one another and whether anything was bothering them. If a mother cannot make her children speak up, something must be wrong. It is a failure of the mother to allow a barrier to exist between herself and her children. The mother must be at fault if the children are afraid to speak to her. They should be free to speak up. The mother must learn to bring out the things that are in her children's hearts. If they do not want to speak up that day, ask them the next day. Guide the children. Let them pray a little and teach them to say a few words. This meeting must be living. Ask them to confess their sins, but do not force them. There must not be any pretense. Everything must be done in a very natural way. Let them take some initiative themselves. If they have something to confess, let them confess. If they have nothing to confess, do not force them. There must not be any pretense. The pretense found in many children is the result of pressure from strict parents. Children do not tell lies, but you can force them to tell lies. The parents should lead them to pray in a simple way one by one. Make sure that everyone prays. Finally, conclude with a prayer of your own. But do not be long. Once your prayer becomes long, children become bored. Feed them according to their capacity. Once you try to do too much, you will overburden them. Pray a few sentences with them and then let them go to sleep." (The Collected Works of Watchman Nee, Vol. 49, pp. 543).

Our intention in preparing these verses carries with it our hope that our next generation will be raised up loving our Lord and His word. As parents in the Lord's recovery, our view is that we have been called to meet God's need in the present age. The richness in a local church can only be realized by "Timothies" being raised up in families that foster a love of these sacred writings. May your family times be established, maintained and become something you treasure.
