



Paper Birdhouse Craft

Matthew 10:29-31

Are not two sparrows sold for an assarion? And not one of them will fall to the earth apart from your Father. But even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Therefore do not fear; you are of more value than many sparrows.

Provided Supplies:

Template

Paper (2 sheets per birdhouse), Can use cardboard for stronger birdhouse

Decorations: Ladybugs, Butterfly, Paper Birds

Straw Perch

Display Verse

Other Supplies Needed:

Glue/Tape

Scissors

Pencil

Instructions:

1. Cut out birdhouse template provided (cut on solid lines, not dotted).
2. Trace onto color/patterned paper provided (or your own).
3. Cut out traced template shapes for birdhouse:
 - a. 2 pieces for house walls
 - b. 1 piece for house roof
 - c. 1 piece for house floor
4. Referring to dotted lines on the original template, fold tabs down on house walls and roof of the birdhouse that you traced and cut out.
5. Attach tabs labeled #1 using tape or glue.

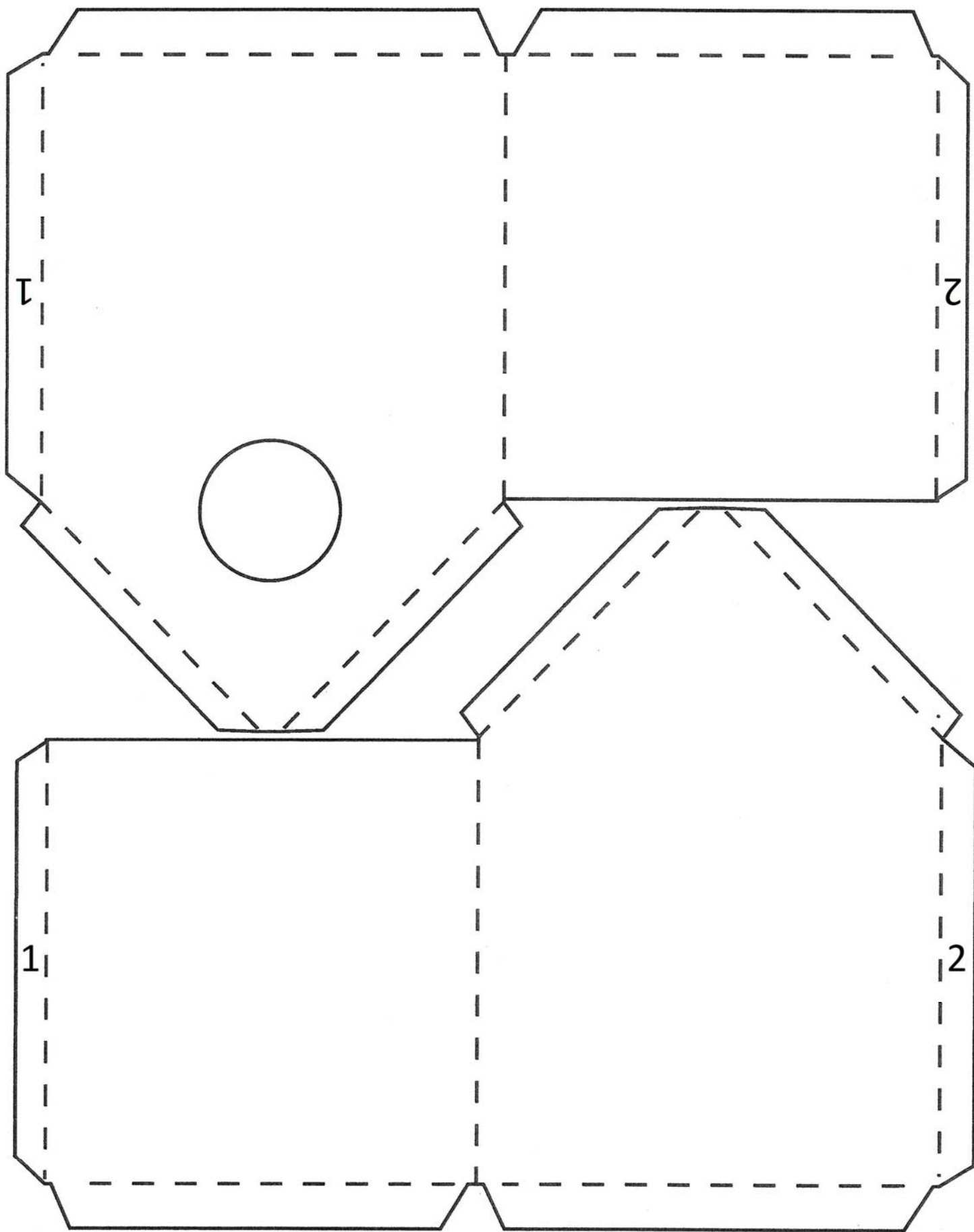


6. Attach tabs labeled #2 using tape or glue.
7. Make sure seams are tight and secure.
8. Apply glue to four tabs on the roof of the birdhouse.
9. Center and place roof over four roof tabs and secure.
10. Hold birdhouse upside down and use pencil eraser to press bottom of tabs securely to underside of roof.



11. Apply glue to bottom four tabs on the birdhouse and press the base (floor) to the tabs.
12. Use hole punch or pencil to put a hole in the front of the birdhouse and push the straw into the hole.
13. Add ladybugs, butterfly, and birds to the house! The insects have adhesive stickers.
14. Apply glue to back of verse and paste on front of birdhouse under the straw perch.
